Your largest issue is going to be trying to do this without a router or AP. Your PC is a end device they are both designed to be connected to a some device acting as a wireless server....ie a router. You do not need to actually connect the router to the internet. The simplest solution would be to buy a small wireless router and use it as a AP. You would then let the camera connect to the AP either via wireless or via ethernet. They make very tiny portable hotspots if size is a concern.
